





(er-MAH-nah)




He likes to sleep.

(foot-BALL)




But does not like to lose.

(es-too-de-AR)




He likes to color.

(cah-ER-say)






But does not like water in his ears.

(o-EE-dos)




He likes **to help** daddy outside.




